III. VARSITY WARMUP

Competition Pool (diving board end): Warmup Pool:

General swim: 12:00 - 1:15 PM Open during competition

Sprint lanes: 1:15 - 1:45 PM No diving

IV. SCRATCHES

Scratches are due no later than one hour before each session.

V. OFFICIALS

Diving: A minimum of 5 Judges should serve as District certified judges.

The Diving Referee will be in charge of obtaining the judges for diving.

Varsity Divers will perform 11 dives

Girls will compete first at 10AM. The boys' event will begin 30 minutes after the

conclusion of the girls' event.

Events and warm-ups may be combined/altered depending on the number of entrants

Swimming: High School Certified Officials will be used. A minimum of six officials for all swimming

sessions are needed to serve as:

One (1) Starter and one (1) Referee Two (2-3) stroke/turn judges Two (2-3) poolside take-off judges.

Meet Committee:

Meet Director, Referee (non-voting), official (appointed by Referee, not involved in the ruling), two coaches and a female and male student representative (nominated by coaches) will serve on the Meet Committee to decide any disputes not directly accounted for in the rules.

VI. SCORING

Scoring to 8 places in individual and relay events.

VII. HOSPITALITY

Hospitality will be provided in the weight room for Coaches, Officials, Administrators, and Meet Staff

VIII. AWARDS

Medals will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, and ribbons to 4th - 8th in both individual and relay events for the Varsity meet.

Championship trophies will be awarded to top Varsity male and female teams.

Individual Recognition of Athletes:

1st Team All District will consist of 1st - 3rd place winners.

2nd Team All District will consist of 4th - 6th place winners.

Academic All District Team (Each team recognized during breaks in competition)

TISCA Coach of the Year will be voted on by the TISCA coaches during the meet.

Swimmer and Diver of the Year will be determined by NISCA Power Points

IX. ADMISSION

Admission Fees: \$5

Admission will be charged at the Varsity Swimming session.

Officials and Meet Volunteers will not be charged.

Each team will submit, by the Wednesday of the meet week, a list of 4 volunteers to help on deck.

All Tickets will be purchased through Go Fan Tickets, no cash accepted at the door.

X. MEET SET-UP AND TIMING

An automatic timing system will be used which should include:

One touchpad, 2 push-buttons and 2 watches per lane.

Each team will supply four volunteers per session.

Air horns, bells and other mechanical noise makers are prohibited in all District sessions.
