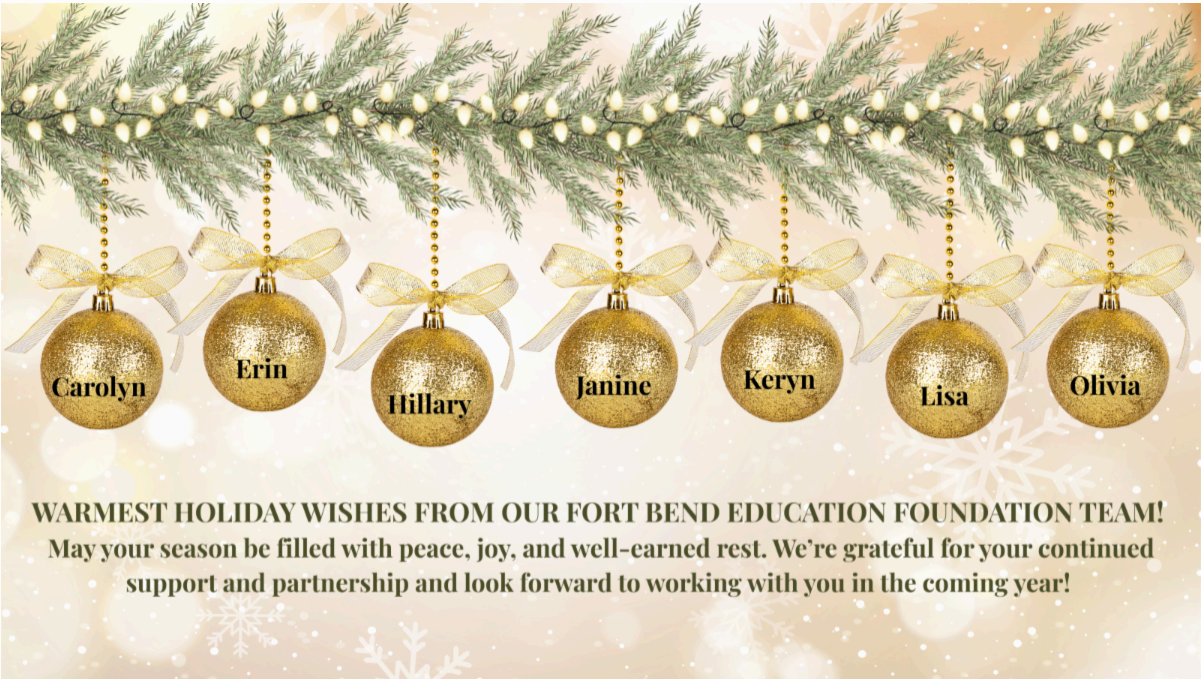

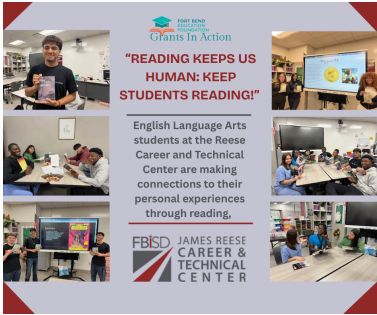
FBEF Annual Sugar Shindig a SWEET Success!

Reese CTC's “Reading Keeps Us Human: Keep Students Reading!” Grant

English Language Arts students at the Reese Career and Technical Center are making connections to their personal experiences through reading, thanks to teacher Dana Moody.

With her \$1,379 teacher grant, Moody purchased sets of graphic novels, classic literature, self-discovery and how-to books for students to enjoy.

Students have taken a “Hero’s Journey” along with Beowulf to learn how good character is developed. They are also learning valuable presentation skills and building community by discussing classics, like *The Lord of the Rings*, with their classmates.



Hightower High School's “Aiming to Animate” Grant

Digital Media Academy students at Hightower High School are continuing to benefit from a \$19,909 Founders Grant awarded to the school to support its “Aiming to Animate” project.

Given the grant, academy teachers purchased HP Desktop workstations, 24-inch computer displays, ports, keyboards and other technological equipment to support student learning.

The students create animations and interactive media, while becoming proficient in industry-standard technology. With the skills they are gaining, the academy students will be prepared for college programs or entry-level positions in digital media.



Madden Elementary's “Does it Stick?” Grant

Kindergarten students at Madden Elementary School are enjoying self-exploration and hands-on learning when using a magnetic science tool to answer the question, “Does it Stick?”

Given a \$1,479 team grant, the teachers purchased Magnet Discovery Boards as an added resource to promote learning during the Forces and Motion Science Unit.

The students view the board of objects – such as nails, rocks and buttons – to predict which will stick to the magnet. The students then move the attached magnet over the board to learn if their predictions are correct. Students enjoy using the tool while exploring the principles of magnetism!
