Using headphones and lap desks, the students are honing English language skills by listening to audiobooks, creating read alouds and engaging in other literacy prompts.

Computer Maintenance & Networking students at the Reese Career and Technical Center are **Geeking Out with Computer Building Kits**, thanks to a \$3,059 FBEF school site grant awarded to teachers. The students use various parts (motherboards, CPUs, graphics cards, memory modules and network adapters) to build fully functional computers and install operating systems, while gaining career skills.

Measuring Dissolved Oxygen in the Lab

Due to a \$1,280 FBEF teacher grant, Travis High School AP Environmental Science students are benefitting from the purchase of optical dissolved oxygen sensors. The tools help students understand how each component of an ecosystem contributes to the chemical conditions of the surrounding environment.
