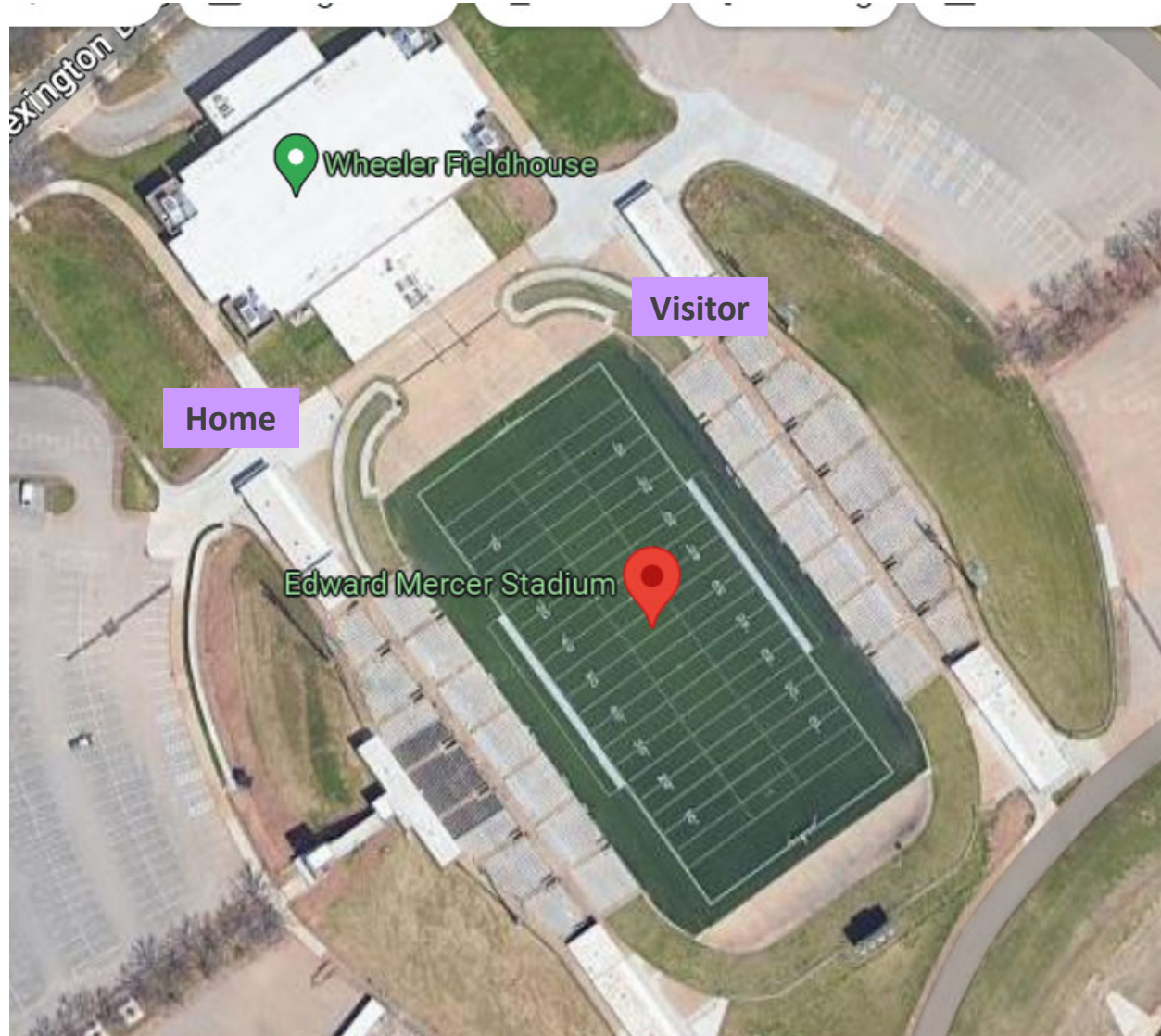

Students: What to Wear

Arrive with
gown off and
draped on arm

Suggested Males: full length slacks preferably shirt with collar, and no sandals

Suggested Females: dress/skirts/slacks, wedges or flats, avoid excessively high heels

Arrive with your gown off, over your arm

No skinny heels, they'll dig into the ground

Do not decorate your cap, gown, or stole

Only wear district issued cords and stoles (no decorated stoles)

Tassel should be worn to the right

No prohibited items

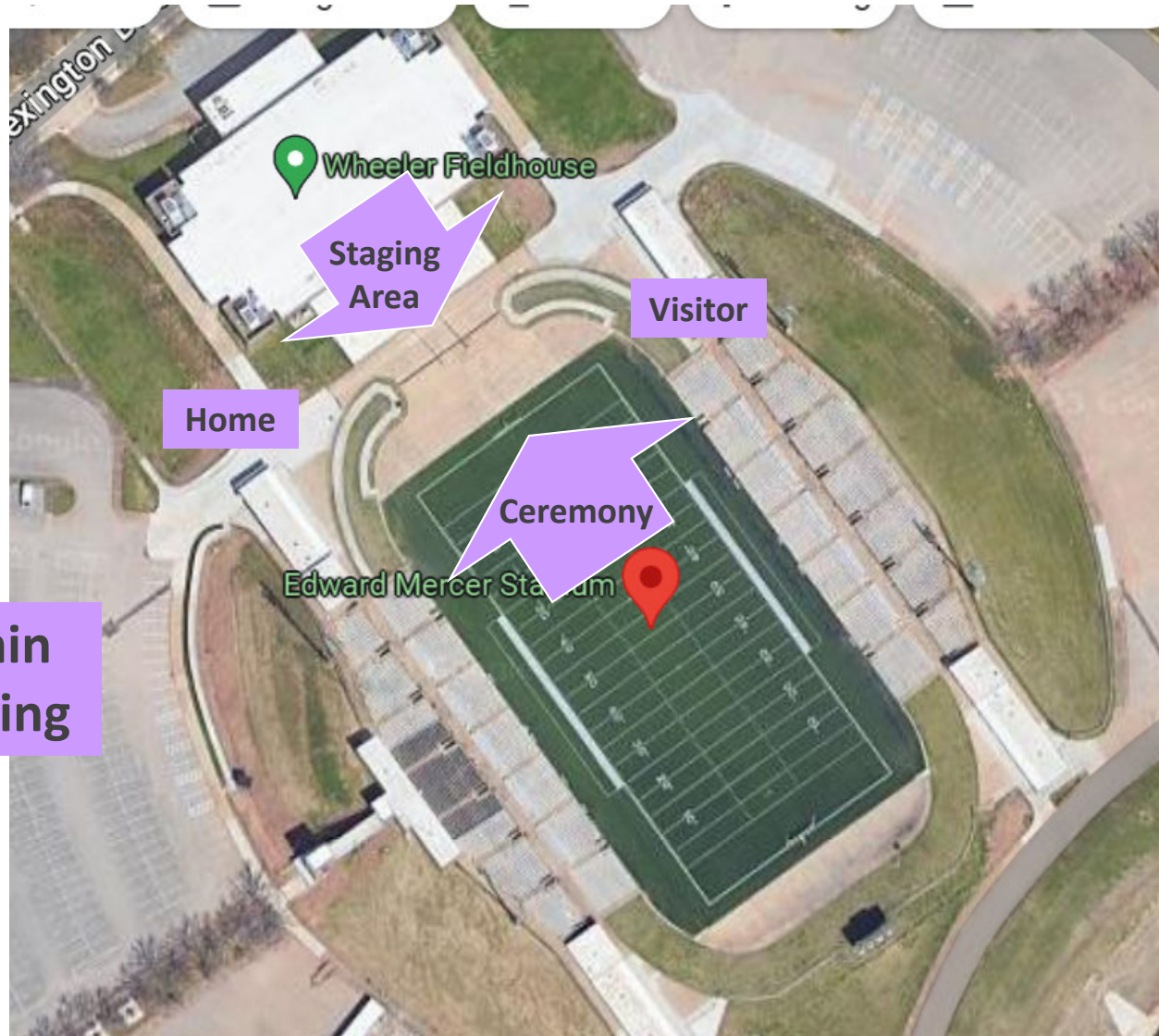


Ridge Point High School Graduation

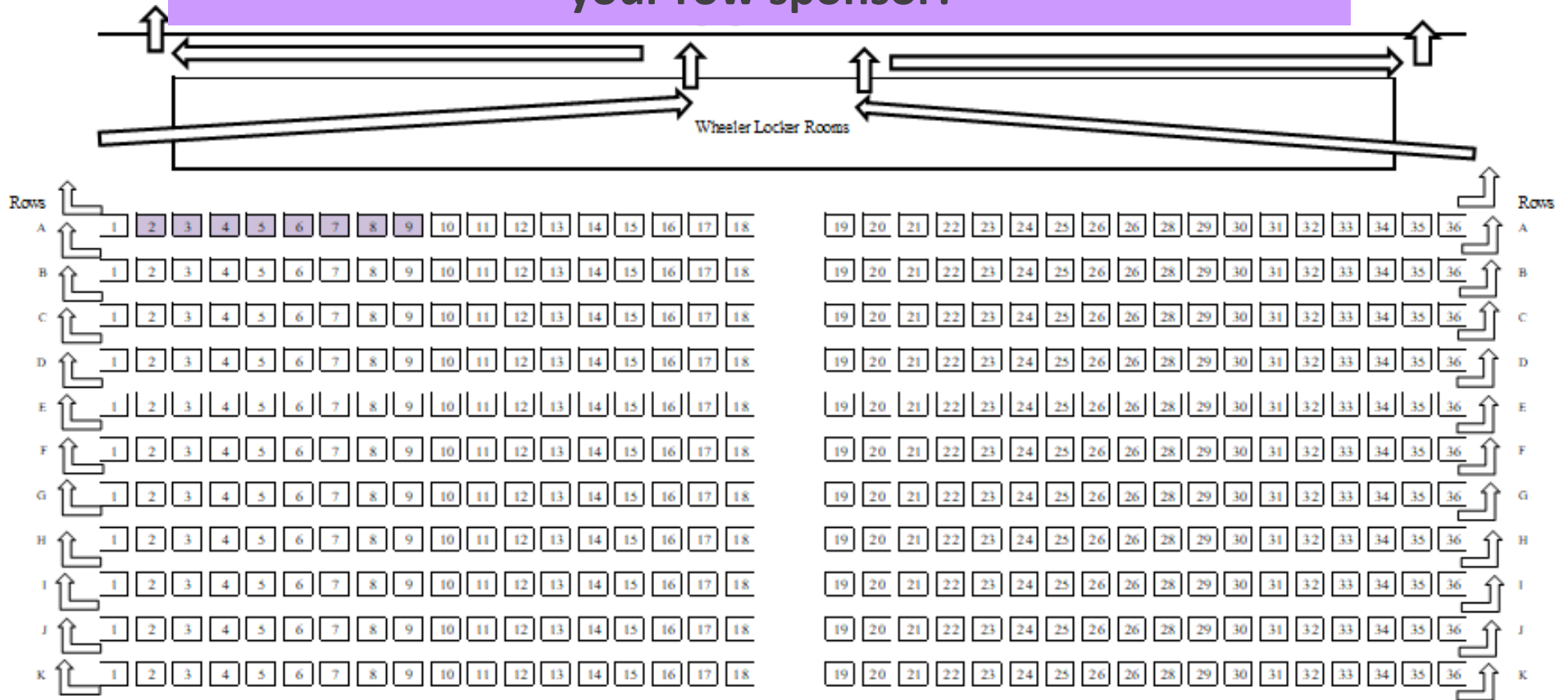

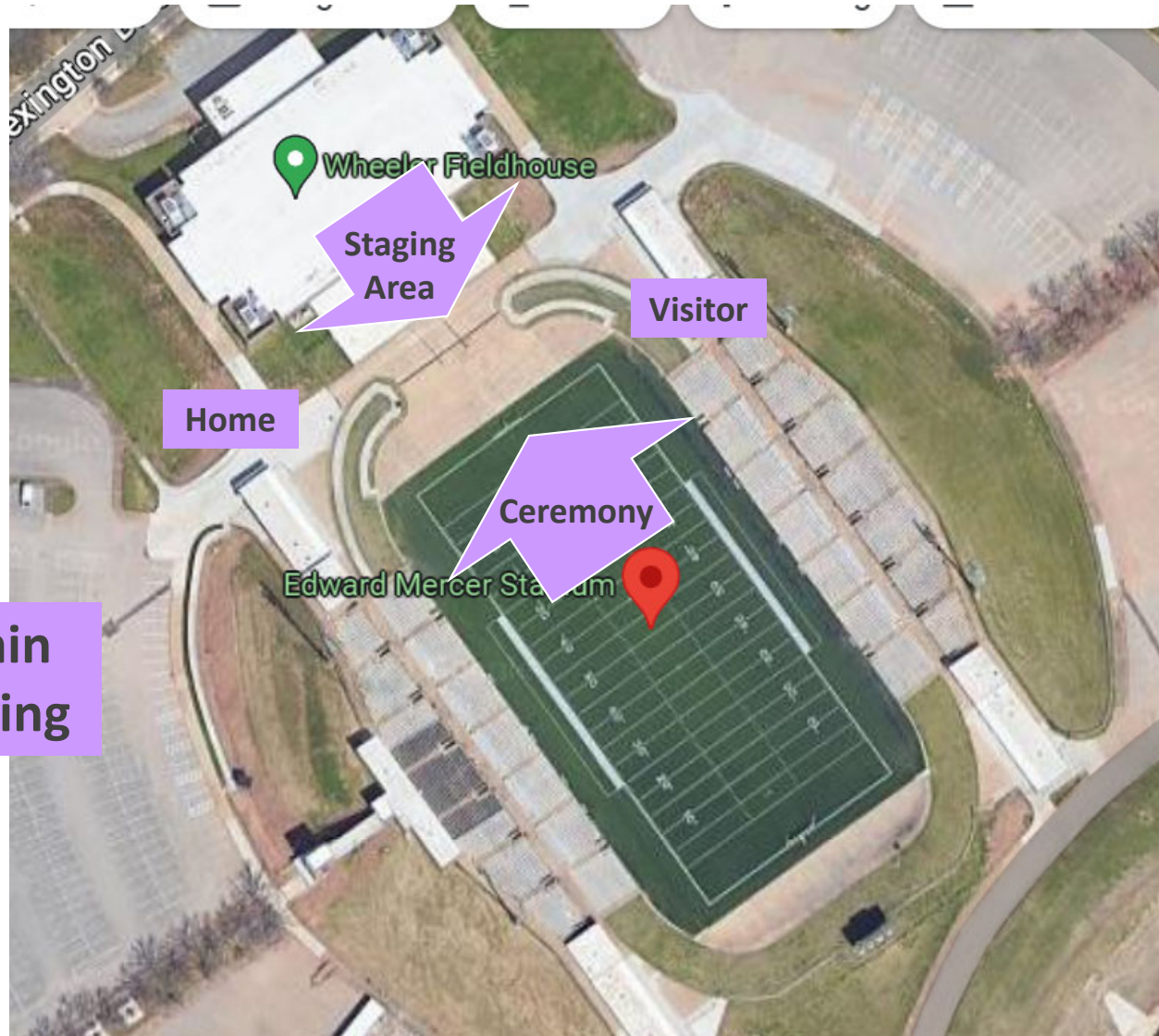

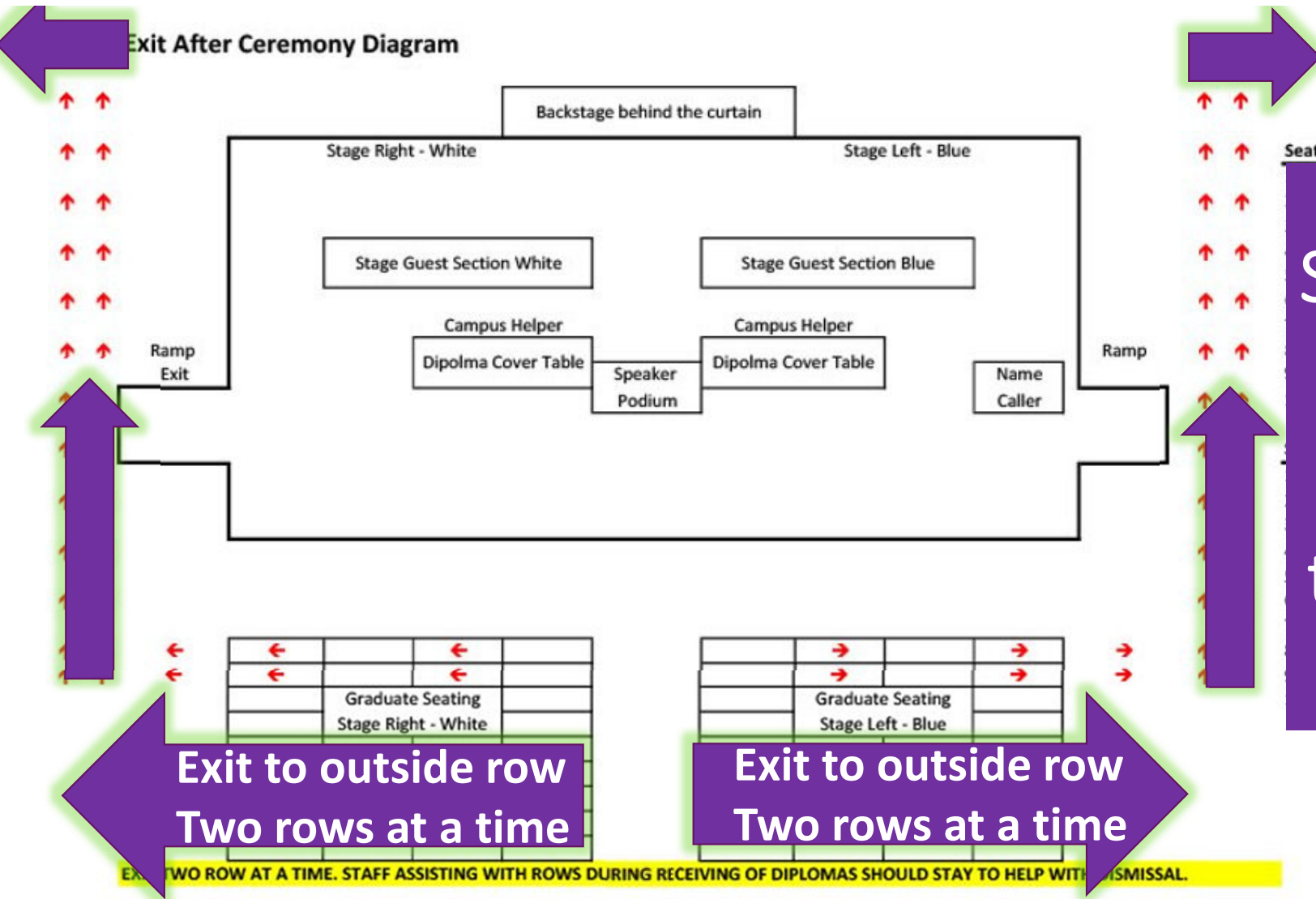

FORT BEND ISD ATHLETIC FACILITIES CLEAR BAG REGULATIONS

In an effort to provide a safer environment for the public and significantly expedite fan entry into the stadium, the Fort Bend ISD Athletics Department will adhere to clear bag regulations for events held at off-campus district facilities.

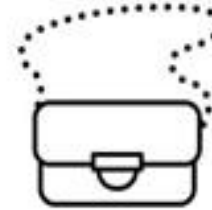
Visitors who bring bags that do not meet the criteria outlined will not be permitted entrance into the venue. Guests who require the use of medical items or equipment can enter any main facility entrance to have their bags screened for admittance.

Permitted Bags



Clear Totes, Backpacks and Storage Bags

Must not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"



Clear or Solid Small Clutch Bags


*Must not exceed 4^{1/2}" x 6^{1/2}"
(approximate size of a hand)*

Guest Information

- Free Parking – carpooling encouraged
 - No tickets required – open seating
 - All 4 entrances will be open
 - Doors open at 7:15p for guests
 - Handicap rails only for handicap guests
 - Clear bag policy
 - Balloons, air horns/noisemakers, banners/flags and confetti are not allowed
 - FAQ on the district website's graduation page

- To check transcript status, graduates must log into Naviance to check if has been sent. Do not call, check Naviance.

Diploma Pick up begins June 20

- Front office Monday-Thursday 8-11am & 1-3pm (closed Fridays)
- Photo ID required
- Only the graduate or parent/guardian listed in skyward may pick up the diploma.

- Delivered to home for senior package purchasers at the end of July and pick up in Aug (TBD)
