*Parent & Student Quick Check Sheet*  
**ARDs, 504, &/or ESL Meetings**

This *Quick Check Sheet* should be utilized by parents/guardians and/or students to help navigate the process to secure SAT & ACT accommodations.

1. In order to apply for accommodations for the SAT tests see chart below: **\*Please Note: This process only needs to be successfully submitted once and if accommodations are approved will be applicable for all SAT exams taken by said student moving forward.**
2. In order to apply for accommodations for the ACT tests see chart below: **\*Please note: This process must be completed each time a student takes the ACT test.**

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Procedures to Secure SAT Accommodations</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A parent or guardian signs the <b>Parent Consent Form (.pdf/194KB)</b> and gives it to the school’s SSD Coordinator or school counselor. If the student is age 18 or older, the student signs the form.</li><li>2. The SSD Coordinator opens a request for accommodations using SSD Online</li><li>3. The SSD Coordinator submits any required documentation to SSD.</li><li>4. The student and SSD Coordinator are notified when a decision is made. If accommodations are approved, the decision letter includes an eligibility letter, containing test-by-test details. The decision and eligibility letters also include the student’s SSD number, which is needed for SAT registration.</li></ol>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Procedures to Secure ACT Accommodations</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Follow the three steps below to get started.</p> <div data-bbox="1049 888 1369 1161" style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 10px; margin-bottom: 10px;"><p style="text-align: center;"><b>1</b></p><p><b>Register to test.</b> Create an account or sign in. Online registration will ask you for your <a href="#">high school code</a> and your accessibility needs.</p></div> <div data-bbox="1040 1213 1369 1486" style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 10px; margin-bottom: 10px;"><p style="text-align: center;"><b>2</b></p><p>You'll receive an email that must be sent to your school official along with a completed <a href="#">Consent to Release Information to ACT (PDF)</a> form. <b>You will need to work with a school official when making your requests.</b></p></div> <div data-bbox="1044 1541 1369 1814" style="border: 1px solid #ccc; padding: 10px;"><p style="text-align: center;"><b>3</b></p><p>Your school official will submit your request, with documentation, to ACT.</p></div>
