# Your Family Might Be Missing Out Acadmically!



# Arriving to school late and leaving early could set your child at an academic disadvantage.

- Just 20 Minutes could lead to your child being behind in any of the core subjects.
- 30 Minutes late or early could lead to your child missing certain learning TEKS (this may be a Science or Social Studies lesson). Leading Too...
  - Lack of academic motivation
  - Issues retaining information from previously lessons
  - Disrupting the learning process
  - Poor Academic Performance

The habits you build with your student now will help your child in intermediate school, high school, and later in their career.

### How Can You help?

- Set up a good night routine.
  - Set out clothes for the next day.
  - o Read before bed and limit screen time.
  - Utilize rewards for following the bedtime weekly or monthly.
- Have an "Exit" plan and try to stick to it every morning.
- Refrain from picking up your child early from school unless absolutely necessary.




