- GT Department Updates (Dr. Westphal):
  - The GT PAC Symposium is this week. The Monday session had over 100 attendees. There was great representation at the noon and night sessions on Tuesday. She wants to thank the PAC executive board and the symposium subcommittee, and the entire PAC for their work on the symposium.
  - The District Virtual TPSP Showcase will be held on YouTube on April 19<sup>th</sup>. It will showcase projects from grades 1 and up. Students have been selected by their schools to make a video talking about their project. On the 19<sup>th</sup>, at about 4:30 pm, videos will be uploaded and available on the YouTube site. Videos will be added throughout the week. A PDF flyer was put in the chat for this meeting, and the flyer was also in the quarterly report that was emailed out today.
  - The District Virtual GT Mentorship Showcase will be held on May 11<sup>th</sup>. It was postponed 2 weeks because of AP testing. Information will be on the GT website.

  - Curriculum Subcommittee: They confirmed the TPSP rollout plan.
  - Secondary Service Design Subcommittee: Completed proposal for GT specific independent study course for high school
  - Student Identification Subcommittee: Completed GT Learning Plan updates and completed universal screener survey

  - The Secondary Subcommittee is having a secondary students’ talk on Friday. The flyer was in the quarterly GT update and was sent with the symposium information.
