Materials

There are no meals provided for this camp. Students are encouraged to bring their own snacks and water bottles. All art supplies will be provided.

Registration

Registration will be taken online only. Art Camp has a registration cap of 40 students; once we reach the cap, registration will be closed and no additional participants will be accepted. There is no waitlist for this camp. Late registration for this camp begins on 5/25, and there is a price increase of \$15 for all late registrations. Payment must be made first and then a separate form will be made available to collect your student's information.

Refunds

No refunds will be given after the first day of camp begins. You may request a refund prior to 5/25 for a 100% refund, and between 5/25 - 6/7 for a 50% refund. Refunds due to cancellation of classes will not be subject to this fee. Contact the Fine Arts Department for any questions regarding refunds.

Scholarships
