


- STARTING 3:25PM
- ON THE DAY CHANGES/EARLY PICK UP Call the front office at (281) 634-4040 and directly contact your student/s homeroom teacher/s before 2pm (early pick up ends at 2:45pm to prepare for dismissal)
- RAINY DAY DISMISSAL FOR WALKERS AND BIKERS
 - Fill out the form given by homeroom teacher to plan for inclement weather. Every student will have given a car rider tag. Please use it if your child is being picked up in the car rider line. Even if they are not normally a car rider.
 - The activation plan will be communicated via email prior to dismissal.
 - Walkers and bike riders are housed on campus until it is safe to release them, or you may pick up at the time stated on the mass notification.

Car riders Expectations for Safety

- Every student will be given a car rider tag. Please use it if your child
 is being picked up in the car rider line. Even if they are not normally a
 car rider.
- Do not drop students of along the street and do not have students walk to your car. Please use the car rider line to keep all students safe.
- **Do not skip through the car rider line.** This is very dangerous, and it will hold up the process for getting your child to your car safely.
- Always have your car tag visible in the car rider line. There will be a staff member queuing your child using the number on your tag. Your child will not know to head out for pickup at the right time if their car rider number is not put in the que correctly.
- Stay in your designated car rider lane once you have been put in the que. Switching lanes will result in a delay when your car arrives to the front to pick up your child.
- Do not go past the designated cones until a staff member has asked you to drive through. There are only "6" spots for pick up in the front of the building. Please do NOT bypass the cones and staff that is monitoring the 6-car que.
- Please stay aware of the flow of the car rider traffic. No cell phones should be in use in a school zone, and this included the car rider line.
- Always remain respectful to the staff and other car riders. Our priority is getting the students safely to their cars.






PRE K TO 2ND GRADE STUDENTS – Handed off to authorized guardian at the pickup location.

Please wait on the sidewalk during pick up to prevent traffic jam on the crosswalks.
