

PGE Rainy Day Dismissal Plan

- Safety is our number one priority, and we will not allow any child to leave at dismissal if lightning and/or thunder is in the area.
- Rainy Day dismissal does last a little bit longer and we appreciate your patience.
- We will call rainy day dismissal between 2:45-3pm.
- We will communicate through Skyward and Class Dojo.
- Parents should provide teachers with their RAINY-DAY dismissal plan.
- Often times, it is pouring at 3pm and the sun comes out at 3:20. Once we call a rainy-day dismissal, we will not change it. However, if you have a walker/bike rider, we may call and ask if you would like them to go ahead and be released.

Please see below for specific directions for dismissal.

- Car riders, Bus Riders, Daycare and Extended Day students will follow the same procedures as a regular dismissal day.
- Walkers/Bikers and Big Tree Walkers will have two options for dismissal:
 - Big Tree Walkers Students walk outside to the fence with their teachers. Students may get wet if it is raining due to no cover/awning. Parents will need to be present to pick up their child(ren) outside the fence.
 - We will release students in the following order: Siblings, 3rd-5th students, K-2 students
 - If parents are not visible, students and teachers will return to the building immediately.
 - If no staff are present, all students have been taken to the front for pick up. Parents will need to come to the front office to check their child(ren) out. Please make sure you have your ID with you.
- Bike Rack Walkers
 - K/1/2/Siblings- will be released out of door #10- under the awning by the bike rack.
 - 3-5th will be released outside the 4th grade hallway/gate.
 - Parents will need to be present to pick up their child(ren).
 - If no staff are present, all students have been taken to the front for pick up. Parents will need to come to the front office to check their child(ren) out. Please make sure you have your ID with you.
