If a discrepancy is identified in a graded area, the inspector will circle the DIS for that area.																			
Knowledge: The inspector will ask 3 questions of the cadet from the Core Curriculum. If the cadet answers the question correctly then the scribe will circle YES if the cadet misses the question, then the scribe will circle NO																			
Cadet grade will be determined by subtracting the total value of discrepancies from 100 points.																			
When the inspector steps in front of the cadet to be inspected, the cadet should greet the inspector by saying: "Good morning/afternoon ma'am/sir. Cadet (Rank, Last Name) prepared for inspection. I am an LE I, II, III, or IV sir/ma'am.
