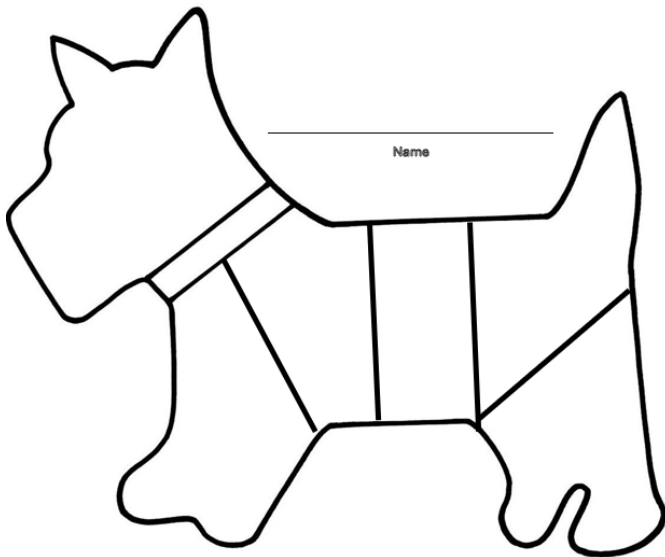


## Spirit Sticks and “Student of the Month”
