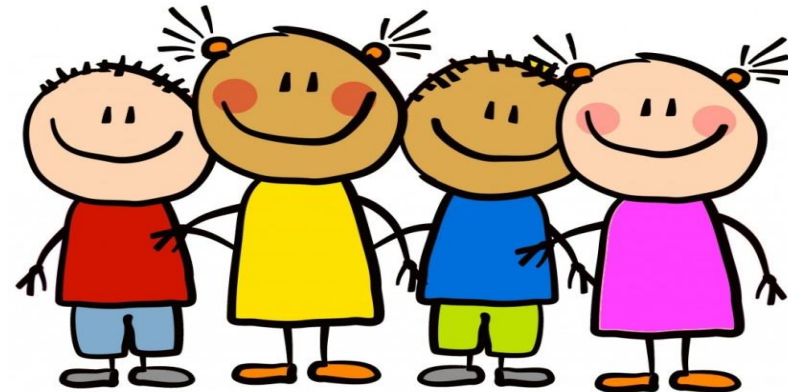

What is PALS?

we do?

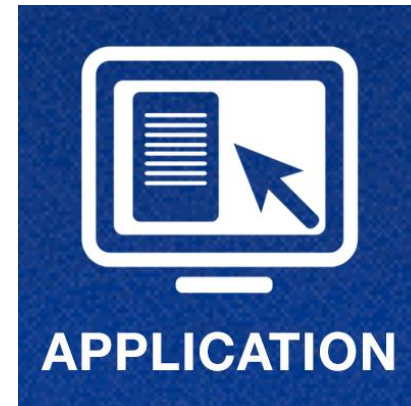


- Greet students on the 1st day of school

How do I apply?

- Due to our current circumstances, PALS selection for 2020-2021 will take place online.
- You will need to access the Schoology Course code: **CRDG-3F4R-VMKNJ** for the application, teacher recommendation form, essay template, and instructions for the interview video submissions.



What is the application process like?

- 1. Submit your application, teacher recommendations, essay (included on application form), and interview video to Schoology on or before May 5th .
- 2. Interview videos and essays will be scored by the PALS Selection Committee. (Please note: Mrs. Jones is not involved in the scoring).
- 3. Your attendance and discipline records will be reviewed.
- 4. Your essay, interview, and teacher recommendation scores will be added together.
- 5. The selection committee will make the final decision of who is admitted into the program.
- 6. You will receive an email during the first week of June to notify you whether or not you have been accepted.
